A California Frame of Mind

The City of California (Mo.) had determined they needed to replace an existing system with a disc system in one of the city's wastewater treatment plants. Environmental Dynamics International (EDI) assessed their need and determined the disc system was suitable for their application.

But this project goes quite a bit further.

After demolition of the old basin structure and installation of the new system, the completed project was a fine-bubble, full-floor coverage, fixed-grid system. Equal distribution in aeration is provided in this new system, which is the most efficient to promote microbial activity.

According to Mike Korman, EDI's director of business development, the new system is already paying off for the city.

"They have already noted the energy savings," said Korman. "The new system has been in operation two months and they are showing thousands of dollars saved per month."

Aeration Works – a division of EDI – performed the installation, which was designed by Korman and EDI President Randy Chann.

EDI has been a supplier to the city for many years, having most recently installed a floating lateral. EDI has future plans with the city to create a second wastewater basin.
